Providing participants with the essential tools required to work in the field, the CCHT 2014 SimEx is a vital exercise for aspiring humanitarians who have some academic training or mid-career international aid professionals alike.

- Practice negotiation and cooperative problem-solving skills
- Gain practical skills in dealing with international medi
- Become competent in all areas specific to humanitarian response including: health, water and sanitation, food, shelter and protection.
